Ding Dong Days BBQ Cook-Off Rules

1. COOKED ON SITE –

All meats will be cooked on-site. They may be marinated off site, but ALL COOKING will take place at the competition.

2. SANITATION –

Cooks are to prepare and cook in a sanitary manner. Infractions identified by the judging committee shall be immediately corrected or the cook will be subject to disqualification.

3. CATEGORIES – PORK LOIN, CHICKEN, PORK SPARE RIBS (NO BABY BACKS)

4. BLIND JUDGING SYSTEM –

This system assures a fair competition. The system requires that 2 tickets bearing the same number be utilized, one firmly attached to the top of the judging tray in a sealed envelope and the second ticket placed in a sealed envelope designated for each team. Winning numbers will not be revealed until time to calculate the grand champion. At this time the secret numbers attached to the tray will be removed matched with the appropriate teams and the results calculated.

5. JUDGING TRAYS –

A Styrofoam tray with hinged lid and without dividers will be given to each competing team by Noon. All judging containers should be clean and free of any marking. Marked containers may be disqualified. Cooks are responsible for insuring that the containers they receive remain clean and undamaged.

6. JUDGING TRAY CONTENTS – **NO GARNISH.**

There should be enough of each to feed 6 judges.

Pork Loin can be pulled, sliced, chopped or all of the above.

Spare Ribs - a minimum of 6 individually cut ribs (bone in).

Chicken – a minimum of 6 individual portions of legs, thighs or breasts

Meats may be cooked with sauces and/or other liquids, but once the cooking is complete, sauces and/or other liquids may not be added once in tray. (NO PUDDLING SAUCE IN THE BOTTOM OF THE TRAY)

7. TURN-IN TIME – Turn in will be at the judges tent at these specified times:

1:00 pm for Chicken

2:00pm for Pork Loin

3:00pm for Ribs

If you are late then your entry will be disqualified. The official time will be displayed at the judge's tent.

8. JUDGING –

Judging will be on taste, tenderness and appearance.

Judging scale:

10 – Excellent

9 – Great

8 – Very Good

7 – Above Average

6 – Average

5 – Below Average

4 – Poor

3 – Bad

2 – Inedible

1 – Disqualified

9. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS –

The BBQ Championship Entry Form must be completed and returned with \$100 Entry Fee payable to **DUMAS WSL** prior to starting fires the day of competition or can be mailed to John Rogers

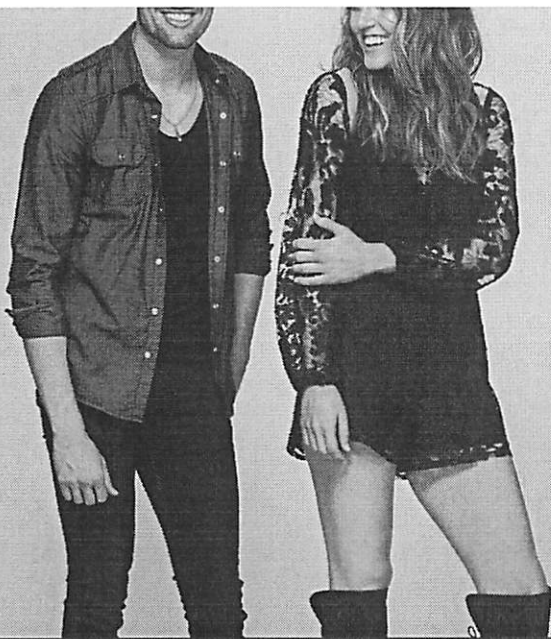
10. TERMS FOR DISQUALIFICATIONS –

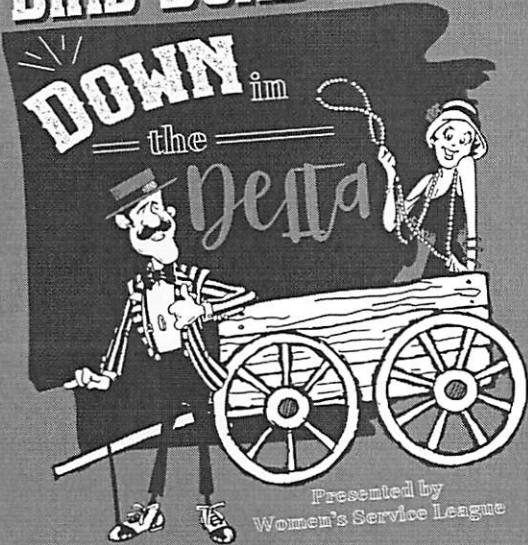
12. PRIZES – Grand Champion will receive \$700. First place in each category will receive \$100. (Additional prizes and prize money may be added as they become available.)
